We are PaletteApp!

PaletteApp is the largest CSI resource library of its kind. We are not a marketing site but rather a resource for the entire commercial construction industry. The platform does not promote any one manufacturer over another. What products are presented to the user is solely based on the filters that the user selects to find the product that they are searching for. The site then randomizes what products are presented to the user so that we insure a completely neutral platform.

Our goal is pretty simple: eliminate waste in the commercial construction industry. Wasted time by architects and designers searching for product, ordering samples or finding specifications, wasted samples for manufacturers, and wasted cost by manufacturers in making sample books. Our goal is not to eliminate the need for samples, simply reduce the number of wasted samples and make the process more efficient.

So how do we make money? PaletteApp feels that it is our responsibility to provide our users the most extensive neutral library and that access should be free. We make money from the premium tools that we develop that save significant amounts of times for architects, designers, contractors, sub-contractors, manufacturers, reps, etc. Manufacturers on the site are not required to pay a monthly fee or subscribe to our Rep App and regardless of whether the manufacturers do or do not subscribe to our Rep App, will not affect how their products appear on the PaletteApp platform.

In short, think of us as a SaaS (Software as a Service) tool, similar to Word or Excel. We simply make the job for the user more efficient.

Marketing Stats:

Marketing people always want to know stats and since we are not a marketing site, we do not share or sell data, period. In fact we do not even collect data on our users except for color selections. However we do have a couple of stats to hopefully appease the analytic types.

How We Load Product:

When loading a new manufacturer we build a json, which is a computer program that crawls the manufacturers site and downloads that data into our product loading tool. The product loading tool allows us to format the information so that there is a consistency of information and product layout regardless of the product type. Manufacturers who work with us can let us know when they have new or discontinued products and we will rerun the json program to update their products. Manufacturers who do not cooperate with PA are scraped once a year to keep their products current.

How We Market Products:

If you review the site, you will notice products featured on the home page. The products featured are selected by our internal design team. Manufacturers do not and can not buy a spot on our home page. We also send out weekly emails blasts featuring product, projects and anything else we find interesting. Again, a space on these emails cannot be purchased but these emails and banners are effective. We have an almost 30% open rate on our emails and almost every manufacture featured in an email gets several new project sample requests minutes after the email goes out.

How We Determine Which Manufacturers to Load:

PaletteApp has compiled a list of over 1600 manufacturers that we plan to load onto the PaletteApp platform. The order in which these manufacturers are loaded is based on the input given by three of the largest global design firms. If a manufacturer wishes to jump to the front of the line, we can review the manufacturers site and determine the fee to build the jsons in an expedited manner.

User Screening:

The PaletteApp platform was developed for the professional commercial construction industry. Every user that signs up for the site is screened and only certain user types are allowed full access to the site. We are very protective of the manufacturers and the cost of sampling and are very diligent in ensuring that any sample request has been vetted.

Benefits to the Manufacturer:

- Reduction in excess sample ordering. Through the palette builder tool, users can see all of
 their finishes together prior to ordering, eliminating samples that do not work for their palette.
 We have seen a reduction of redundant fabric sample waste by over 80%, carpet by 50%.
 We will continue to measure this information and work diligently to reduce the 72% of
 samples ordered and then discarded.
- Less time for your Customer Service Department or rep to spend on handling a sample or specification requests. If you have an automated system, we will gladly work with you to tie in our system.
- Less time for your Customer Service Department or rep to spend on assisting architects or designers in creating a project binder and specification book. This equals more selling time for the rep.
- Produces a better quality of lead by screening all users and only allowing professionals in our industry the ability to order samples
- Collects better data for these leads, such as Project Name, Project Size, Project Budget and Project Location and feeds this data to the manufacturer.



- Provides the manufacturer with better project intelligence and expands your reach deeper into the A&D market.
- Our ultimate long-term goal is to reduce the need to make costly sample books at all.

Benefits to the Rep:

- Reduction of time gathering and sending specification, warranty, maintenance, installation and misc. documents for the user.
- Access to potentially more clients, especially smaller firms that typically get ignored.
- Better project data collection

Benefits to the Architect/Designer:

- Reduction of time searching for product.
- Reduction of time ordering samples.
- Reduction of time downloading specification information.
- Reduction of time creating project binders.
- The basic tools will save a four person design team 30 days per year

Benefits to the GC/Sub-Contractor:

- Easier access to finding products, especially specialty products.
- Reduction of time ordering samples for submittals.
- Reduction of time downloading specification information.

Premium Products:

PaletteApp Rep – A subscription based and web-enabled app for manufacturer representatives

Function: Allows manufacturer reps to manage clients project info, order their own samples (etc.)

Benefits to the Manufacturer/Rep:

- Reduces time to order samples. Can process reps own samples for customer in seconds on site, along with reducing the amount of time to find and send technical data.
- Will allow reps to coordinate customer/order data on PaletteApp with organizations CRM of choice (Salesforce, Sugar, PaletteApp, etc.)
- History of all sample orders for future review
- Saves 5-7 hours per week per rep allowing for additional appointments with clients. Multiline reps will save even more time.

PaletteApp Student – Provide a <u>limited</u> number of samples (60/yr) to students enrolled in architecture and interior design programs. This is a subscription-based service for the students.

Benefits to Manufacturer:

- Establish early relationships with students who will become customers at design firms after graduation.
- Provides student quality and up to date product samples and information for their projects
- Minimizes the time it takes a student to compile a palette



- Reduces the amount of time it takes to download specifications and project binder
- Students can only order 60 samples per year and pay an annual subscription fee. This will minimize the worry of excess sample ordering by students

PA Annex (2016) – This will be a new site that is linked to our database. Manufacturers will be able to sell discontinued or excess inventories. Because of the link to our database, any discontinued product information will be automatically loaded, reducing the amount of time it takes to upload product for sale. The site will also allow subcontractors to sell excess or left over materials from their projects. PaletteApp will manage all of the sales process including any applicable taxes and shipping.

Color Forecasting (2016) – You will have options for viewing the colors selected for your products, your entire industry or all industries on the PaletteApp platform. This tool will help you better determine which color ways to offer for a new product line. (Subscription Service)

Database Storage (2016) – PaletteApp would be happy to store your data in our database. As mentioned before we do not sell or share data, so the information would be secure and readily accessible.

White Label Sites (2016) – PaletteApp has been asked by several large manufacturers to be the only product on the platform for their type of product. While this is not feasible for PaletteApp, we can build a site that would be linked to your companies website that has all of the products featured on the PaletteApp platform but you as the manufacturer could remove any manufacturer or manufacturers product that conflicts with your current product offering.

Site Tools:

Palette Builder Tool – Users can create visual palettes of materials for projects.

The PaletteApp user can sort thousands of products in a matter of minutes to select their fabrics, furnishings and finishes for their project.

Benefits to Manufacturer:

- Reduces sample waste. Users are able to see all of their finishes together and will order only the samples they need to present to their clients vs ordering an entire line hoping to find what will work for their design.
- PaletteApp reaches customer in territories and areas where there is minimal rep coverage or no reps at all.
- User can quickly and easily download specifications and create a project binder, reducing the time the manufacturer rep or customer service department has to spend sending technical data to the architect or designer.



Future Reports That We Are Building For Manufacturers:

Product Views – Which products have been viewed and how many times for each, but not who.

Palette Inclusions – Each time a product is included in a palette, whether ordered or not, it will be included in the report. Both the product name and colorway is included. This can be used as part of your product and color forecasting efforts.

Sample Orders – Any products ordered during the month will be documented on the report, and a history of all sample orders will be available.

Sample Report Copy - Included at the end of this document.

Manufacturer/User Support:

Support: Our team will be traveling the country visiting both our manufacturing partners and A&D professionals. We are doing this in an effort to bolster the awareness for the PaletteApp site and to support your sales staff. We are available to travel with your reps, train your reps and clients on how to efficiently use the site and for your national sales meetings as well. All we ask is that you schedule a minimum of four (4) client meetings per day. We are also including installation images on our product pages. If you have any installation images and would like to provide them, you can do so via DropBox as well. The more high quality images, the better. Our goal is to show your products in the best possible light.

Recommended Image Specs (Print Quality):

- At least 8 in by 8 in (2400 pixels by 2400 pixels) at 300 dpi
- · Acceptable formats are: JPG, GIF, PNG or TIF
- Each file should not exceed 6MB in file size
